ABLE -

having the power, skill, means, or opportunity to do something.

We must trust God in Faith - Hebrews 11:1

DO -

perform (a particular task) work on (something) to bring it to completion or to a required state, achieve or complete.

We must take action based upon our Faith in God - James 2:26

Philippians 1:6

6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:

POWER

Spiritual power is the divine energy God provides in and through the believer along with the divine authority necessary to carry out the work He has called us to do.

Spiritual power is not just for preachers, evangelists, or individuals who serve in a particular specialized ministry. Spiritual Power is available to every believer who surrenders in submission in obedience to the Holy Spirit.

Acts 1:8

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

God gives us Spiritual Power to provide the encouragement, strength and ability to do the work to which He has assigned us. His power fully equips and enable us.

Maximizing your Power

1. Submission

We experience His power when we are willing to surrender and be used by Him. God releases His power through us as we walk in obedience to Him.

1 Peter 5:6

6 Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

2. Study

Know God and His will for your life by studying and meditating upon his Word constantly

2 Timothy 2:15

15 Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

3. Seeking Continue to develop by seeking and striving to be just like Him. Strong Christian character empowers the work that we do for the Lord. Through the fruit of the Spirit, God's power and only God's power enables us to exhibit love, joy, peace, patience, goodness, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control, which reveal the character of Christ in us. **Galatians 5:22-23**

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

4. Supplication(asking, begging earnestly and humbly)

Stay in communication with God has work and walk in relationship with Him.

Philippians 4:6

6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

5. Starting

Step out on Faith and get busy about God's business.

Philippians 3:14

14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

6. Shouting

Give God glory in all we do, praise Him

6 Let every thing that hath breath praise the Lord. Praise ye the Lord.
