"CHECKING YOUR PRIDE"

PRIDE-Pride is excessive belief in oneself or one's own abilities that interferes with the individual's recognition of the grace of God. It has been called the sin from which all others arise. Pride is also known as vanity.

HOW GOD FEELS ABOUT PRIDE

- √ Proverbs 21:4--"An high look, and a proud heart, And the plowing of the wicked are sin."

- When you look down on others because of their lack of materialism, appearance, job, etc...
