RIGHTEOUS

- What church should I attend?
- Should I marry him or her?
- How should I react to my enemy?

WHAT IS DECISION MAKING?

Making a decision is a process that includes making a choice or judgment about an attitude or action. Decisions are an act of the will, and they are always influenced by either the mind or emotions.

- ✓ Your decisions receive God's blessing when you are willing to obey God.
- ✓ Your decisions should be based on what you know to be God's revealed will.
- ✓ Your decisions ultimately reveal the desires of your heart.
- ✓ Your decisions are ultimately determined by what you desire the most. The fundamental principle for each of us becomes, "Do I choose to please myself, or do I choose to please the Lord?"

- Decisions that come by faith-Heb 11:6
- Decisions that consider the interest of others-Phil 2:4
- Decisions that are bathed in prayer-1 Thes 5:17

"Could this cause another person to stumble?"

SERENITY TEST-Phil 4:6-7

"Have I prayed and received peace about this decision?"

SUPREME TEST-1 Cor 10:31

"Does this glorify God?"
