◆ "SON OF DAVID" WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

- The title "Son of David" carries significant weight, especially when applied to Jesus. When people called Jesus the Son of David, they were saying they believed He was the promised Messiah, the one who would restore Israel and bring God's kingdom. Son of David is a Messianic title that signifies Jesus royal lineage and fulfills Old Testament prophecies.
- **It is a title of honor, as well as an indication that the person so designated could claim descent from him.**

Who was David?

David was the greatest king in ancient Israel.

- ✓ He united the tribes into one nation.
- ✓ He secured undisputed possession of the country.
- ✓ He established the will of God as law in the nation.

Matthew emphasizes the special relationship of Jesus to King David. Matthew is intentional with showcasing the association between David and Jesus.

- **Matthew prioritizes David in the lineage.**
- **Matthew highlights David's kingship.**

◆ **JESUS IS CONNECTED WITH DAVID BY HIS TITLE**

The Old Testament promises that you will know the Messiah by His works.

Isa 32:1-3; 33:17

- He will preserve the sight who see.
- He will grant sight to those who can't see.

Isa 35:5-6

- Eyes of the blind will open.
- Hearing granted to the deaf.
- Lame man shall leap.
- The tongue of the mute shall sing.

The New Testament confirms that Jesus is the Messiah.

- Luke 7:19-22-John the Baptist
- Mark 10:46-Bartimeaus

◆ **JESUS IS CONNECTED WITH DAVID BY THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF HIS BIRTH**

Jesus and David share the same place of origin, the little village of Bethlehem.

The Old Testament stresses that David was from Bethlehem.

- 1 Sam 16:1,4,18; 17:58

The New Testament states that Jesus was from Bethlehem.

- Matt 2:5-6,8,16

The Old Testament foretells that the Messiah would come from Bethlehem.

- Micah 5:2
